



## Fees

Tuition Fees for the academic year 2009/2010 are as follows:

- Junior School £2,454 per term
- Senior School £3,093 per term

The King's School Tynemouth has charitable status. Every effort is made to keep the fees as low as possible, consistent with the high standard of education provided, but prompt payment of the fees is essential if the school is to achieve its aims.

School fee invoices are despatched at the beginning of the holiday period immediately prior to the relevant term and fees are due on the first day of the term. The school operates a Direct Debit system by agreement, allowing a full year's fees to be paid by monthly instalments over the ten-month period September – June.

The tuition fee is fully inclusive and no additional charge is made for extras such as examination fees and personal accident insurance. School lunches are not included.

With the exception of personal accident insurance (above), the school does not provide, and is not allowed to advise on, insurances. Parents should seek the advice of their financial adviser.

## Scholarships and Remissions

Scholarships are available to pupils entering Year Seven, Year Nine and Lower Sixth. These are awarded on the basis of academic performance, current Headteacher's report and interview. Art, Music and All-rounder awards are also available. Scholarships may be worth up to 50% of school fees.

In cases of need it may be possible to arrange remission of fees from The King's School Bursary Fund.

Discounts on fees are also available to children of the clergy, and to third and subsequent siblings.
